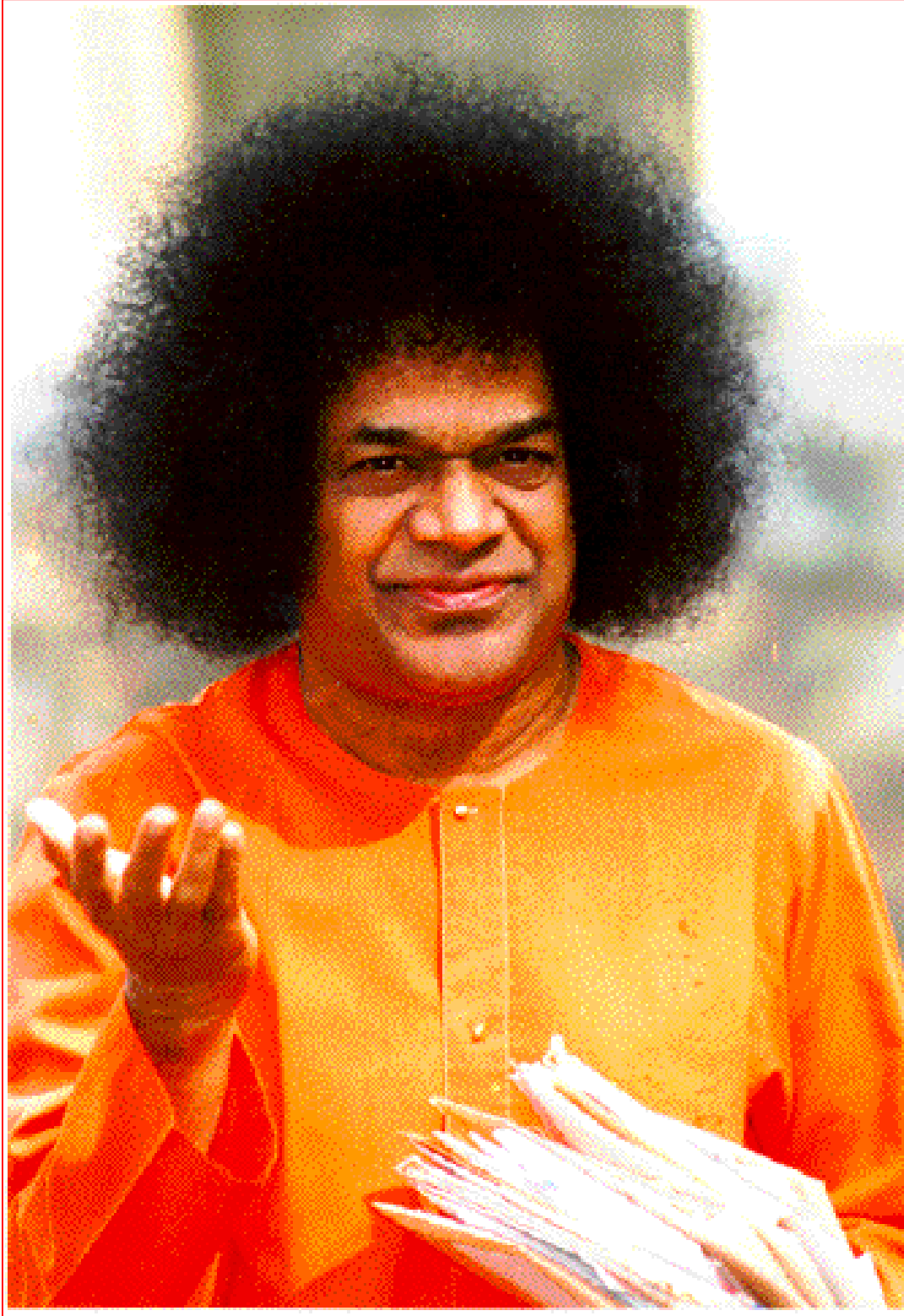

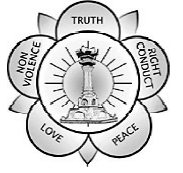


LIKITHA JAPAM (writing the name of God)

The following points are advised:

- Maintain physical and environmental purity in order to keep your thoughts pure during this exercise.
- Use legible writing with no crosses or dirty marks.
- Use the same name of God throughout the book.
- Use a similar type of pen throughout the book, to ensure consistency of presentation.
